

Brief Introduction to Jiujiang Tongwen High School Средняя Школа Тунвэнь города Цзюцзяна

Jiujiang Tongwen High School (also named Jiujiang No.2 Middle School), founded in 1867, is one of the key schools in Jiangxi Province. The school, covering 74,000 square meters, now has 341 teachers, over 5,000 students and 96 classes. In addition, the school is constructing another campus, and the era of “one school, two campus” is approaching.



Students are from 7 grade to 12 grade (7-9 grade, middle school students and 10-12 grade, high school students). English goes through all grades and is the key subject of all grades. The school provides compulsory courses, optional courses, Tongwen-based courses, after-class courses.

Simultaneously, the school has over 50 students clubs: broadcast station, newspaper press, literature club, arts club, Chinese Kongfu club, Pingpang club, Basketball club, football club, Tennis Club etc. The school has also many festivals: Tongwen Forum, Arts festival, PE festival, Science and Technology festival etc.



Over 30 years, Tongwen High School has been establishing sister schools, and providing more than 20 kinds of foreign activities for students and teachers. Employing foreign experts, hosting AFS program exchange students, sending AFS program exchange students, China-Singapore SM2 Scholarship program, American Sister City Youth Scholarship program, Hungarian Government Scholarship program, sending school delegations to sister schools, PT volunteers living and working all are Tongwen styles.
